

PROPOSAL

Listen to the Personal Stories of Displaced Migrants

Practice inclusivity by coming together as a work team to listen to the stories of refugees in Germany, while supporting programs that provide safe spaces for displaced migrants to integrate into their new communities.



WHAT YOU'LL DO

For this experience, your team will have the opportunity to listen to up to five different individuals about their displacement from their home country, and their subsequent relocation to Germany.

The session will begin with a brief summary about the speakers' lives. After hearing these introductions, you and your team will split into groups to interact more closely with at least one of the speakers. Depending on the number of participants, the groups will consist of up to eight participants. In these breakout groups, you will hear details about a displaced migrant's authentic experience, with the opportunity to ask questions and if possible, offer brief coaching to the speaker.

Finally, the group will reconvene for a general Q&A and to share your takeaways.

HOW YOU'LL MAKE IMPACT

Liberty Experience provides safe spaces and opportunities for displaced migrants to integrate and economically contribute to the German community. IMPORTANT STATISTICS

Germany has one of the highest numbers of refugees of any country worldwide.

As at 2020, at least 2million refugees (or with refugee background) live

in Germany.

Since 2013, an average of 3,500 migrants/year are reported dead or missing in Mediterranean

Wealthier countries can do much more in protecting people who have left everything behind.

About 130,000 refugees settle in Germany every year.

Appeals for humanitarian assistance for refugees are consistently underfunded.


